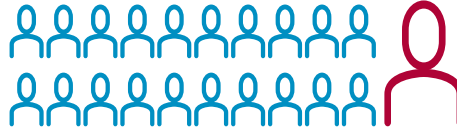

ONE OF A KIND:
The U of A broke ground on the **Multi-User Silicon Carbide Research and Fabrication Facility (MUSiC)** in fall 2023.

This facility will enable the federal government – via national laboratories – businesses of all sizes, and other universities to prototype with silicon carbide, a capability that does not presently exist elsewhere in the U.S.


